## Board of Trustees:

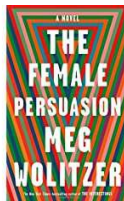
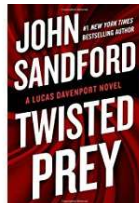
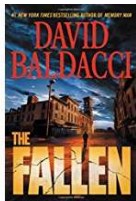
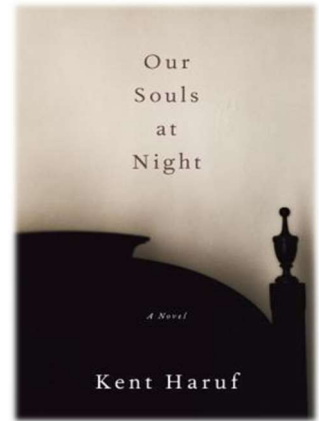
The Board of Trustees meeting is Monday, April 16<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm.
